Jean-Marc Lafont Blanc de Blancs Crémant de Bourgogne, NV Beaujolais, France

Winemaker Jean-Marc Lafont and his wife Annick have been running Domaine de Bel Air in the Beaujolais region of Burgundy since 1985. The chardonnay grapes for this crémant come from a southeast facing vineyard with a siliceous-clay and limestone-clay terroir, giving the wine its elegant character. Grapes are harvested by hand from vines averaging 30 years old, and the resulting crémant is matured in the bottle for 18 months.

Barter and Trade Sauvignon Blanc 2017 Columbia Valley, Washington

Winemaker Andrew Jones of Field Recording Winery in Paso Robles, California, seeks out small growers at sites that are unknown or underappreciated, but hold enormous potential. He personally selects the best fruit from each to produce interesting wines from unusual vineyards. This wine features sauvignon blanc from the Ancient Lakes of the Columbia Valley.

100% Sauvignon Blanc

Umani Ronchi Vellodoro Pecorino 2018 Marche, Italy

The pecorino grape variety, with its high aroma concentration and outstanding acidity, was typically used to improve the quality of wines made with other varieties. Because of its low productivity, pecorino had almost disappeared from vineyards. Beginning in 2005, the Bianchi-Bernetti family, owners of the Umani Ronchi estate since 1957, undertook a project to rediscover native Adriatic varieties, including pecorino. This wine rests in stainless steel tanks for 4 months in contact with its yeasts, but does not undergo malolactic fermentation.

100% Pecorino

Walsh Family Chardonnay 2018 Purcellville, Virginia

Sarah and Nathan Walsh founded Walsh Family Wine in 2014. They have 50 acres of vines on five sites in Loudoun County. Nate's career began at Horton Vineyards in Gordonsville, Virginia before working at wineries in Oregon's Willamette Valley and New Zealand. He was then winemaker at Sunset Hills Vineyard in Purcellville before opening his own winery with Sarah, whose background is in fine dining and wine sales and education.

100% Chardonnay

Domaine Roumagnac Fronton Ô Grand R 2016

Fronton, France

Located 18 miles north of Toulouse, Domaine Roumagnac was founded in 1880 and since 2008 has been run by the fourth generation of the Roumagnac family. Half of the estate's 35 acres are planted in négrette grapes which are grown exclusively in the Fronton region (except for small amounts grown in California). Legend has it that the Knights Templar brought the grape to France from Cyprus. The two varietals in this wine come from the oldest vines on the estate and are separately vinified. They are blended just after fermentation and aged on the less for 15-17 months.

50% Négrette, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

Bedrock Wine Co. Cabernet Sauvignon Montecillo Vineyard 2017 Sonoma County, California

Founded in 2007 by Morgan Twain-Peterson, Bedrock's mission is to preserve and rehabilitate old vineyards around California. Montecillo Vineyard sits at the top of the winding and rough Nelligan Road on the northern edge of the Moon Mountain District. Owned by Karin Lee, the vineyard contains some of the oldest remaining cabernet in California. Bedrock's block on the estate, planted at an elevation of 2000 feet in the 1960s, is dry-farmed on a widely spaced "California Sprawl" trellising system.

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Caraccioli Cellars Carbonic Fermentation Pinot Noir 2018 Gonzales, California

A family run winery, Caraccioli Cellars was founded in 2006 in the Santa Lucia Highlands of Monterey County. Grapes for this wine were harvested by hand on 11 September 2018, using small totes instead of large bins, to reduce pressure on the fruit. The whole-cluster grapes undergo carbonic fermentation or carbonic maceration (fermentation in a carbon dioxide-rich environment) before crushing This process ferments most of the juice inside the grape, leading to wines low in tannins. This Beaujolais Nouveau-style wine was aged for just one month in neutral French oak and was bottled on 29 November 2018.

100% Pinot Noir

Lovo Moscato Giallo Veneto, Italy

Terre Gaie (Happy Lands) is a family operation directed by Salvatore Lovo, his wife Rita Ferasin, and their daughter Silvia. The estate is in the village of Vò at the western end of the Colli Euganei (Euganean Hills) in the heart of Veneto's wine production area. The winery produces about 150,000 bottles of high-quality estate-grown wine from the most favored hillsides of the region. The winery dates from 2004 and was built on the existing property of the Lovo and Ferasin families who have owned vineyards in Vò since the 18th century.
