Chef Roberto Donna is a native of Turin in the heart of the Piedmont region of Italy and is renowned for his sophisticated Italian cuisine centered around seasonal ingredients. The Italian government awarded him the *Insegna del Ristorante Italiano* in recognition of serving the best authentic Italian food outside Italy. Esquire magazine named him Chef of the Year in 2012. He even defeated Masaharu Morimoto on Iron Chef America in 2006.

Bailliage members may recall our October 2020 at-home event for which Chef Roberto Donna delivered an amazing seven-course Piedmontese dinner to members' homes and then spent the evening with us on Zoom coaching us through the final preparation of his dishes.

This October, we have the wonderful opportunity to experience Chef Donna's cuisine in-person at his eponymous restaurant. Roberto's Ristorante Italiano opened in February 2022 to rave reviews and was quickly included in Tom Sietsema's 2022 Spring Dining Guide in the *Washington Post*. The chef is crafting a multicourse menu just for us, which will be paired with wines from the bailliage's cellar.
